



# Dorking Banking Hub is open!

Your local shared banking hub is open in its temporary home at Pippbrook – Mole Valley District Council Offices, Reigate Road, Dorking, Surrey, RH4 1SJ

Monday to Friday, 9am to 5pm.

## At the banking hub you can:

- Withdraw cash
  - Deposit cash and cheques
  - Make balance enquiries
  - Pay utility bills
  - Access other cash services, such as floats and coinage (for registered businesses)
  - Talk to a community banker from your own bank about managing your account, payments and transfers, getting online – and many other things
- × The banking hub is not a Post Office so you **can't** send parcels or buy stamps



Banking Hub





The UK's major high street banks have worked together to bring shared cash and everyday banking services to your community.

The hub has a counter service operated by the Post Office, where customers of all major banks and building societies can carry out regular cash transactions.

There is also a private space where you can speak to a community banker from your own bank about more complicated banking issues.

The community bankers work on rotation, with a different bank available on each day of the week:

**Monday:** HSBC

**Tuesday:** Barclays

**Wednesday:** Santander

**Thursday:** NatWest

**Friday:** Lloyds
